Hellebore The Clown

MAURICE ROWDON

Clowns, some say, are a dying race. But if ever a sad day comes when The Great Clowns are no more, and people who have never seen them wonder what they were like, we could confidently recommend them to read this remarkable book. The hero of Mr. Rowdon's first novel is a famous clown about to make his come-back in a Paris variety theatre after the first world war. Haunted by the death of his son, uneasy that his powers may have waned, Hellebore practises for the great moment. We see the human being behind the grease-paint—egotistic, arrogant, yet lovable, single-minded, and of extraordinary personal magnetism: a true artist. There are vivid sketches of Hellebore's impresario and fellow-performers. The novel reaches a magnificent climax with the First Night, when, after an initial failure which sends the reader's heart into his mouth, Hellebore gives a masterly performance. The description of this performance, with all its tension, near-tragedy, humour and triumphant virtuosity, is a tour-de-force which marks out Mr. Rowdon as a writer of the highest promise.
